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## TOURNAMENT RULES

- 1) All games will be played to AENA rules, except where tournament rules apply.
- 2) All games will be 15 minutes one way in a continual game, with 5 minutes between games to change courts.
- 3) There will be a central timer for every game so please make sure that you are organised and on side within the 5 minute change over.
- 4) Points will be awarded as follows:  
**5 points for a win**  
**3 points for a draw**  
**1 point for a loss**
- 5) Each team is required to provide their own umpire, of a C award standard or above.
- 6) The starting centre pass in each game will be taken by the team that is written first on the fixture. This will be organised by us in a fair way so that it alternates accordingly throughout the teams.
- 7) Captains are required to check their players nails, hair and jewellery before the games begin. We will not be liable if injuries are caused from scratches or jewellery.
- 8) No substitutes can happen during the 15 minutes of game play unless a player is injured.
- 9) Umpires are to keep record of the score throughout the game - score cards will be provided.
- 10) Spectators and other team members who are not taking part during a game must keep the sidelines and back-lines free and behave in a respectful manner.
- 11) Please make sure that all children are supervised at all times.
- 12) We will not accept liability whatsoever for any personal loss or injury, which players, officials or spectators may sustain
