In critical situations, blood or other medical items need to be delivered urgently to save a patient's life. Blood bikes with their distinctive livery, emergency lights and highly-trained riders, can cut through traffic quickly and safely. Your Donations fund....

Every £1 you donate will improve or save lives

£30 pays for life saving medication to be delivered to a patient at home

£80 pays for donor breast milk to be delivered to a Neonatal Intensive Care Unit

£250 pays for a blood bike for a whole shift and could help save 10 lives

£1000 pays for blood to be delivered to the air ambulance service for one month
